Our excellent and motivating teaching is designed to encourage our students to become independent, enquiring, and critical thinkers.



An inspiring, challenging and responsive academic curriculum which balances the best of traditional and online classes




ENGAGING CURRICULUM

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



GCSES YEAR 10 AND 11

Our broad and versatile curriculum not only enables students to flourish academically but also develops skills for life.

Most pupils will sit 7-9 GCSE's, we encourage a broad range, and specialisation is left as late as possible in order that decisions about future careers are considered carefully and options are left open.

A LEVELS YEAR 12 AND 13

A levels enable students to experience the intellectual challenge and stimulation of studying subjects in much greater depth before they go to university.

Students can study up to 4 A Level subjects which can be taken in any combination and tailored to fit the student's future goals.
