- Complete coursework, revision or weekly assignments.
- Talk to Student Support Advisors.
- Ask subject staff for help when available.
- Discuss work with other students.
- Network, socialise and build connections.

Before you attend

You must book your place at least one week before the session.

This helps us make sure we have enough workspace, computers, staff support and refreshments available. Please do not attend without booking in advance.

WHAT TO EXPECT

A relaxed, supervised study session - not a formal taught lesson.

ARRIVE & SET UP

Bring your laptop or use a College computer. Connect to Wi-Fi and settle into your work.

Work independently, talk to other students and use the time to stay organised.

Student advisors and subject staff will be available to help when needed.

Staff and supervision

Staff support is available

Student Support Advisors and subject staff will be available during the session. You can ask questions, discuss your progress or get guidance with your studies.

Teachers may move in and out of the room

A teacher may not remain seated in the classroom for the full two hours. This is intentional and gives students space to work independently and connect with one another while still having access to support.

Sessions will be monitored to help maintain a safe, respectful and productive environment for everyone. Students are expected to be considerate of others who are studying and to use the space appropriately.
